

SAFETY CHECKLIST

Overview

To prepare your Motorcycle, ATV, or side-by-side for transport within New Zealand:

1. Clean it thoroughly to remove dirt (especially for MPI/quarantine), reduce fuel to under a quarter tank, remove loose accessories\ mirrors, and photograph it for damaged documentation
2. Ensure your bike and any single Box are very well labelled with your name and phone No.

Pre-transport Checklist

<p>3. Cleaning (crucial)</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Ensure the bike is spotless, including the engine and tyres, to meet strict MPI inspection standards.</p> <p>Even on a national basis, ensuring the bike is clean, free of oil and grease ensures it is safe to manage your valuable asset.</p>
<p>4. Fuel Level</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Reduce fuel if possible to prevent leaks and reduce fire hazards.</p>
<p>5. Accessories</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Remove panniers, saddlebags, GPS, mounts, and aftermarket accessories.</p>
<p>6. Documentation</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Take detailed, dated photos of the bike from all angles to document its condition.</p>
<p>7. Battery</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Disconnect the battery for shipping if you deem that prudent.</p>
<p>8. Nothing Loose</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Make sure there are no loose parts or accessories.</p>
<p>9. ID / Label Keys</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Tie all keys together, add phone number to keys.</p>
<p>10. Bike Insured</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Make sure your bike is insured for transit.</p>
